



THE FIRST MAN

FOCUS

GENESIS 2:6-7 & 19

Adam was the first man, and was formed from the dust on the ground by God. It was his job to name all the animals that God had made.

MATERIALS

Crayons and paint

Adam Picture
Kinetic sand (1 cup per child on a paper plate)
Animal coloring pages (1 per child)
What's it called Adam song (1 per parent)
Animal wooden magnet (1 per child)

ACTIVITIES

1. INTRODUCTION

TALK: Ask children if they know who Adam is. Introduce him as the first man God made.

ACTIVITY: Show children the Adam picture and hang nearby for them to see.

CORRESPONDING VERSE

2. DUST FROM THE EARTH

TALK: At the beginning, the earth was covered in dust. God sent a mist over the dust and the dust became like wet sand. He molded animals and Adam out of the wet sand and breathed life onto them.

ACTIVITY: Have kids try to make a person out of the kinetic sand then breathe on it.

ACTIVITIES

3. NAME THE ANIMALS

TALK: It was Adam's job to name the animals.

ACTIVITY: Each child gets an animal coloring page (the same for the coloring page and wooden magnet). Each child colors their own coloring page and was asked what they would name that animal.

BONUS: Sing "What's it called Adam" song while children are coloring. Handout one to each adult so they can sing along too.

READ: Read Adam from Bible Stories for Boys


5. PAINT YOUR ANIMAL


TALK: Ask children to make their own animals sounds.

ACTIVITY: Paint animal magnet. (I encouraged the children to put the magnet on their fridge so they can see it and remember what we learned.)



It's big and blue Let's call it a whale


It hops and ribbits Let's call it a frog
