#### **DANIEL WEEK 1**

#### THE DREAM

#### **FOCUS**

DANIEL 2:2-3, 5-7, 10, 24 & 28

King Nebuchadnezzar had a dream that troubled him! He asked his wise men to tell him the dream and what it meant but they couldn't! So Daniel asked the king for time and with the help of his friends and prayer, God revealed the mystery!

#### **MATERIALS**

The Dream picture

King (in PJ's), Wise men (1-3) and Daniel actors and songs

Consequences coloring page (1 per child)

Magnifying glass (1 per child)

Bulletin board with squares

Groceries (various sizes and weights)

1st - 3rd clues (1 per child)

Large statue and mountain

Timeline coloring page (1 per child)

Crayons, markers, tape and glue

#### **ACTIVITIES**

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

TALK: Ask the children if they know who Daniel is. Explain that Daniel was a man who lived in Israel, but was taken captive by King Nebuchadnezzar and moved to Babylon and served the king.

ACTIVITY: Show children the Dream picture and hang nearby for them to see.

#### 2. THE DREAM

TALK: One day the king had a troubling dream. He could not sleep and finally he called in his wise men to help. But the king knew that this dream was important, so he tested the wise men to make sure they would tell the truth. He asked them to not only tell him what the dream meant, but what he dreamed too! The wise men told him that they couldn't do it, and that no one could tell the king what he had dreamed. This made the king very angry and he told the wise men they would be killed!

ACTIVITY: Have king and wise men sing the "I've had a dream" song.

#### 3. CONSEQUENCES

TALK: The king asked the wise men to solve a mystery! He told them that if they did not solve the mystery they would be cut into pieces and their houses turned into piles of rubble. But if they did solve the mystery they would receive gifts and rewards and great honor!

ACTIVITY: Have children color the flip-up consequences page.

#### 4. A MYSTERY

TALK: The wise men asked the king for time to solve the mystery, but the king knew no matter how much time he gave them, they would not tell him the truth. The wise men were given no clues to solve this mystery and immediately claimed they could not do it. They didn't even try!

ACTIVITY: Give each child a magnifying glass. Then let them see a large bulletin that has 3 squares on them. Let children inspect the board to see if they can solve the mystery.

#### **ACTIVITIES**

#### 5. TRY THEN ASK

TALK: The wise men gave up and told the king it was too hard! Without any clues or help they could not do as the king asked! When your parents ask you to do something and you think it is too difficult do you whine and say you cannot do it? Or do you try? We need to learn that when we are asked to do something, if we really try and cannot do it ourselves then we can ask our friends or parents for help! They would rather see us try and fail and ask for help then to not try at all! Like when are parents ask us to help bring in the groceries from the car. If we cannot carry something big, we can start small! Like bring in a loaf of bread then come back and bring in a box of cereal! We can start small, then when we get bigger, we can carry heavier things!

ACTIVITY: Create an obstacle course. At the start have a series of groceries. A grocery bag full of boxed food, a large package of paper towels or toilet paper, etc. The children will be required to bring them from one end of the driveway or room to the other. Designate an area for the groceries to be brought to, by making a line or having them placed on a large piece of flat cardboard or blanket. Have children stand at the beginning of the obstacle course in a line. They are to take turns lifting one item to the designated spot. If they cannot do it themselves, they are to ask their friends or parents for help!

#### 6. DANIEL TRIES

TALK: Daniel heard that the king had sentenced all the wise men to death! That meant Daniel and his friends would die too! But Daniel knew that the king really wanted to know what his dream meant, and Daniel wanted to help him! He went to the king and asked for time, and the king said yes! Then he asked his friends to help and they all prayed to God to reveal the mystery! Daniel uses three tools; time, friends and prayer! Do you think the wise men would have had the tools they needed if they had asked God to help too?

ACTIVITY: Daniel comes before the children and says he heard what the king wanted to do.

DANIEL: I have just come back from seeing the king. I asked him for time to figure out this mystery and he said yes! I have also asked my friends to help and pray with me. Will you help me solve this puzzle too?

Play charades to find out the first clue. Start with time. After they figure out its time, give them the first hint (for example, the first clue is on the back wall). Using their magnifying glasses, have children use the hint to find the first clue (the top half of the statue). Once found, play charades for the second hint (friends), then use that hint to find the second clue (bottom half of statue). Play charades for the third hint (prayer) and then have them find the third clue (mountain). After they found the clues have them glue them together on a board from activity 4. The first clue on the first box, second on the second and third on the third.

#### 7. MYSTERY REVEALED

TALK: After Daniel asked for time, help from his friends and prayed to God, God revealed the mystery to Daniel!

ACTIVITY: Have Daniel sing "You've had a dream" song to king. After the song, have Daniel explain the dream to the king as he puts the pieces of the statute together and glues the mountain on top of both.

DANIEL: God has shown you the future! There will be four great kingdoms! Then after these kingdoms there will be a gigantic kingdom that is like a rock! That kingdom will last forever!"

KING: Thank you Daniel, your God is the God of gods and the Lord of kings and a revealer of mysteries! Now I can sleep!

#### 8. THE CONCLUSION





#### BULLETIN BOARD


