### FIRE



#### **MATERIALS**

#### **ACTIVITY**

### IDOLS

TALK: The king wanted Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego to bow down to gold! Oh no! He wanted them to bow down to an idol!

ACTIVITY: Let's read Acts 17:29 then find one object that is gold, silver and stone. Then ask your Tiny Arrow some questions like: Can they break? Are they powerful? Can they help you? No! They are not real! We cannot think of God as something that was made, he is special! He is Divine!

## SAYING NO

FOCUS MATERIALS

Asking God to help us to say no to unholiness!

**ACTIVITY** 

CORRESPONDING VERSE

### DO NOT WORSHIP

TALK: Let's remember the story about Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego saying no! The king, who was in charge, asked them to do something against God's will! He asked him to worship an idol!

ACTIVITY: Let's pray that God will help us to know when something is unholy, and to stand up and say no too!

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## WORLD'S WAY VS. GOD'S WAY

#### **FOCUS**

Knowing the difference between God's way and the world's way.

#### **MATERIALS**

2 jars Strips of paper

#### **ACTIVITY**

GOD'S WAY

TALK: Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego chose God's way, not the world's way. While everyone else was bowing down to the idol, they knew that it was against God's commandments and did not do it! They choose to obey God rather then the world!

ACTIVITY: Get two jars, on one write "world's way" on the other "God's way" then get some strips of paper. Let's monitor what our Tiny Arrow does and write down if it is something that is the worlds way, or God's way. We will focus on the 10 commandments. If they follow the commandments or not. Then have them place the paper in the appropriate jar. Look at what is in each jar at the end of the day.
