Joshua the Aide coloring page (1 per child)


ACTIVITY


ACTIVITY: Color Joshua the Aide coloring page.

JOSHUA THE AIDE



JOSHUA

FIGHTING THE AMALEKITES

FOCUS

EXODUS 17:8-16

Refresh on the Joshua fighting the Amalekites.

MATERIALS

ACTIVITY

WAR

TALK: Let's read Exodus 17:8-16.

The Amalekites came and attacked the Israelites at Rephidim. Moses said to Joshua, "Choose some of our men and go out to fight the Amalekites. Tomorrow I will stand on top of the hill with the staff of God in my hands." So Joshua fought the Amalekites as Moses had ordered, and Moses, Aaron and Hur went to the top of the hill. As long as Moses held up his hands, the Israelites were winning, but whenever he lowered his hands, the Amalekites were winning. When Moses' hands grew tired, they took a stone and put it under him and he sat on it. Aaron and Hur held his hands up—one on one side, one on the other—so that his hands remained steady till sunset. So Joshua overcame the Amalekite army with the sword. Then the Lord said to Moses, "Write this on a scroll as something to be remembered and make sure that Joshua hears it, because I will completely blot out the name of Amalek from under heaven." Moses built an alter and called it The Lord is my Banner. He said, "Because hands were lifted up against the throne of the Lord, the Lord will be at war against the Amalekites from generation to generation."

Exodus 17:8-16

ACTIVITY: Replay the race we had during class. It is a variation of red light green light. When your hands go up your Tiny Arrow races towards you. When your hands are down, they run away. The goal is to get to you "Moses".

THEIR INHERITANCE

FOCUS

DEUTERONOMY 31:7-8

Refresh on the land Joshua will lead the Israelites to inherit.

MATERIALS

Israel coloring page (1 per child)

ACTIVITY

ISRAEL

TALK: Let's remind our Tiny Arrows that Joshua started out as Moses' Aide, but Moses was not allowed to enter the promised land, so he had to assign a person who would lead after him and God picked Joshua! Moses brought Joshua in front of all the Israelites and told them he would be the next leader.


ACTIVITY: Color Israel to see the land that Joshua would lead the Israelites to inherit!

TALK: Let's read the corresponding verse then talk about what Moses would have seen.


ACTIVITY: Color the coloring page, then have them fill in some of the areas, mountains, valleys, rivers, sea and desert.

FOCUS MATERIALS

Focusing on a task, following directions and replicating the result.

ACTIVITY

LEARNING FROM THE BEST

TALK: Talk about the relationship between Moses and Joshua. Joshua watched what Moses did, he saw where he did things well, and where he made mistakes. But by the time Joshua became leader he would have been able to do what Moses was able to.

ACTIVITY: Today let's pick a task simple enough that your Tiny Arrow can do it on their own, but requires direction. Do that task three times today. Once all by yourself with them watching, a second time with them helping and a third time all by themselves. Tomorrow they will do the task by all by themselves!

ACTIVITY: Today let's have our Tiny Arrows do the task we practiced yesterday. Try to have them do it all on their own with little to no help, just verbal instructions if needed.
