FOCUS

1 CHRONICLES 25:7, ROMANS 12:4, 1 CORINTHIANS 12:4-6 & 18, EPHESIANS 2:21 & COLOSSIANS 3:14-16

We all have our own job in the church body. Some are called to do some things, and others something different, but each one is important!

ACTIVITIES

1. INTRODUCTION

TALK: Ask the children if they can name some jobs people might have in the church body.

ACTIVITY: Show children the Your Job picture and hang nearby for them to see.



2. DIFFERENT JOBS

TALK: In God's kingdom we form one body all working towards one goal but we each have different jobs! We need to be thankful for the job that we have!

ACTIVITY: Glue the different objects onto the people!

ACTIVITIES

3. ONE BODY

TALK: We are apart of one body! One person is the feet, the other the legs, etc., if we are not working together rightly we cannot function properly.

ACTIVITY: Have the children copy you as you draw the shapes to make a body; head, torso, legs, arms, eyes, nose, mouth, ears, hands, feet, etc.

4. WORKING TOGETHER

TALK: Each part of our body works together to make us whole, just like each part of the church body works together to make it whole. God made us all differently, but we are suppose to work together!

ACTIVITY: Split children up to create the different parts of a body (body, head, eyes, mouth, ears, feet and hands).

5. ONE HOUSE

TALK: We are all in God's house and need to do our part! We cannot build the house by ourselves and each person is made to build a specific part!

ACTIVITY: Have each child cut out and assemble a house with shapes of paper (house, roof and door).

6. BUILDING

TALK: Building a house requires a lot of pieces to make it stable and secure. Each person must work on their job to the best of their ability or the house will not work as well. You should not just work independently by together as well. Working together makes the bricks on the walls connect so the house is stronger!

ACTIVITY: Assign each child a part of the house to build with Popsicle sticks or blocks. Place children in small groups to build it together.





when everyone's done they put it all together.





LARGE BODY

BODY

Have a child lay on a 4'x5' white sheet of paper and trace their body outline

HEAD

Have a child cut out a large circle from 8.5"x11" colored paper

HANDS

Have child trace and cut the shape of their hands with 8.5"x11" colored paper

FEET

Have child trace and cut the shape of their feet with 8.5"x11" colored paper

EYES

Have a child cut out two small white circles and two smaller black circles and glue together

HAIR

Have a child cut and bind together a handful of 25" pieces of colored yarn

MOUTH

Have a child cut out a semi-large red semi-circle for the mouth from red paper




Have a child cut out 2 half circles for the ears from colored paper


To create the house you can use Popsicle sticks, blocks, or something that stacks. First I demonstrated the strength of the house by showing two different pre-built houses. The house on the left has walls made independently and the house on the right has walls that join together. I showed them how the house on the left was weak and the other was strong.



Then I encouraged them to build a house as a small group with walls that are joined together.










GLUE SHAPES ON PAPER IN THE FORM OF A HOUSE








8 RUBBER BANDS PAPER > TOWEL ROLL (OR SOMETHING SIMILAR) 2 CRAYONS


DRAW A 3-4" CIRCLE

CUT 6 RUBBER BANDS IN HALF









CUT 6 SMALL HOLES 1/2" APART IN THE MIDDLE OF THE BOX NEAR THE EDGE & LACE THE CUT RUBBER BANDS THROUGH THEM







STRETCH THE RUBBER BANDS ON THE OTHER SIDE, LACE THROUGH THE HOLES & TIE IN THE BACK PLACE THE CRAYONS UNDER THE RUBBER BANDS WITH THE GROOVES UNDER EACH BAND




SECURE WITH THE UNBROKEN RUBBER BAND





CUT AN "X" IN THE CENTER
OF THE EDGE OF THE BOX
