ARROW

arrow IN THE HAND OF A WARRIOR

FOCUS

PSALM 127:4, PROVERBS 4:1-3, 11 & 25-26

Your Tiny Arrow is an arrow! They are meant to learn from their bow, father, so that when they are released they can remember their instructions and obey right away!

MATERIALS

Bow and Arrow picture (1 per child) Bow and Arrow (1 set per child) Target Crayons, paint, marker and tape

ACTIVITIES

1. INTRODUCTION

TALK: When a father has a child they are like a warrior and their child an arrow!

ACTIVITY: Color the picture of the father holding a bow and the son an arrow.

2. BOW & ARROW

TALK: A bow and arrow is like a someone who is discipling someone (a father), and someone who is being discipled (a child). The father will train, teach and release their child for their calling.

ACTIVITY: Have child paint an arrow. While he is painting say Proverbs 4:1-2. After the arrow is dry, write the child's name on the arrow, and their father's name on the bow.

ACTIVITIES

3. TAKE HOLD

TALK: As an arrow you are suppose to take hold of your father's words. You should listen to what he says and obey the first time!

ACTIVITY: Write a scripture or God's purpose for your family on the target then have your Tiny Arrow grab a hold of the arrow as you tell them what it says on the target! Hang the target on the wall (somewhere you can shoot the arrow at).

4. SEE & OBEY

TALK: When you're an arrow, you need to fix your eyes on where your father is telling you to go. He will help you go straight and right where you need to go!

ACTIVITY: Play I spy, encouraging your Tiny Arrow to look for what your are explaining and to fix their gaze on it. Use the target as one of the items you have them try to find.

5. FLY STRAIGHT

TALK: At the point when an arrow is being released, this is when your ear is by the mouth of the person holding the bow. What they are speaking, you are empowered to do! You can listen and obey! Your father will lead on you straight paths, and will help to show and tell you where you need to go.

ACTIVITY: N rel the bow and show them how when the bow is stretched the nock is right by your lips, then shoot the arrow at the target.

6. RELEASED

TALK: Once your parent has told you where you need to go and what you need to do, this is when you should quickly obey!

ACTIVITY: Have child walk or run to retrieve the arrow. Encourage them to go straight for the arrow.

OPTIONAL: Hand out each child a bible verse to take home.





USING A SAW, CUT APPROX 1/4" IN THE MIDDLE OF ONE SIDE OF THE ARROW TO FORM A NOCK


INSERT TWINE IN BOTH SIDES OF CUT HOLES AND TIE TOGETHER BRING OTHER END OF STRING DOWN

- BEND

INSERT A SMALL AMOUNT OF GLUE FROM A HOT GLUE GUN INTO THE ERASER CAP THEN INSERT THE DOWEL INTO THE EASER CAP AND PRESS FIRMLY UNTIL DRY

INSERT TWINE IN BOTH SIDES OF CUT HOLES AND TIE TOGETHER

CUT OUT TARGET & HANG IN A SAFE LOCATION THAT IT CAN BE SHOT AT
