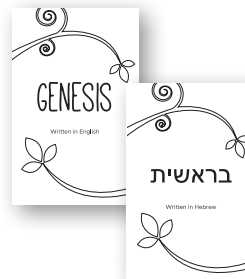

ACTIVITIES

1. INTRODUCTION

TALK: Hebrew is the one of the oldest languages, and is what the Israelites speak! The Bible was first written in Hebrew! You read English left to right, and Hebrew right to left!

ACTIVITY: Color the book of Genesis 1 in English and in Hebrew; pointing out the differences.



CORRESPONDING VERSE

2. ALPHABET

TALK: The English alphabet has 26 letters, and the Hebrew alphabet has 22!

ACTIVITY: Review and count the differences between the English and Hebrew alphabet. Then practice writing the letters in the **sand box**!

BONUS: Play memory match with the **extended alphabet & sound cards**. (These cards show the multiple sounds some letters can make.)

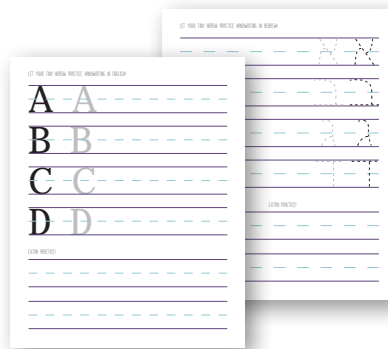


ACTIVITIES

ACTIVITY: Practice tracing and writing the first few letters of both alphabets!

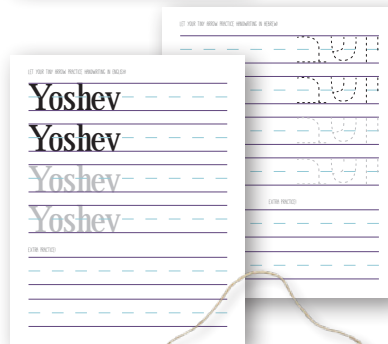


4. YOUR NAME

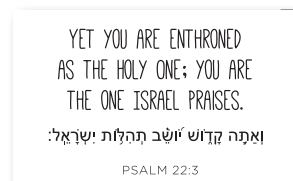
TALK: Yoshev was first written in Hebrew!

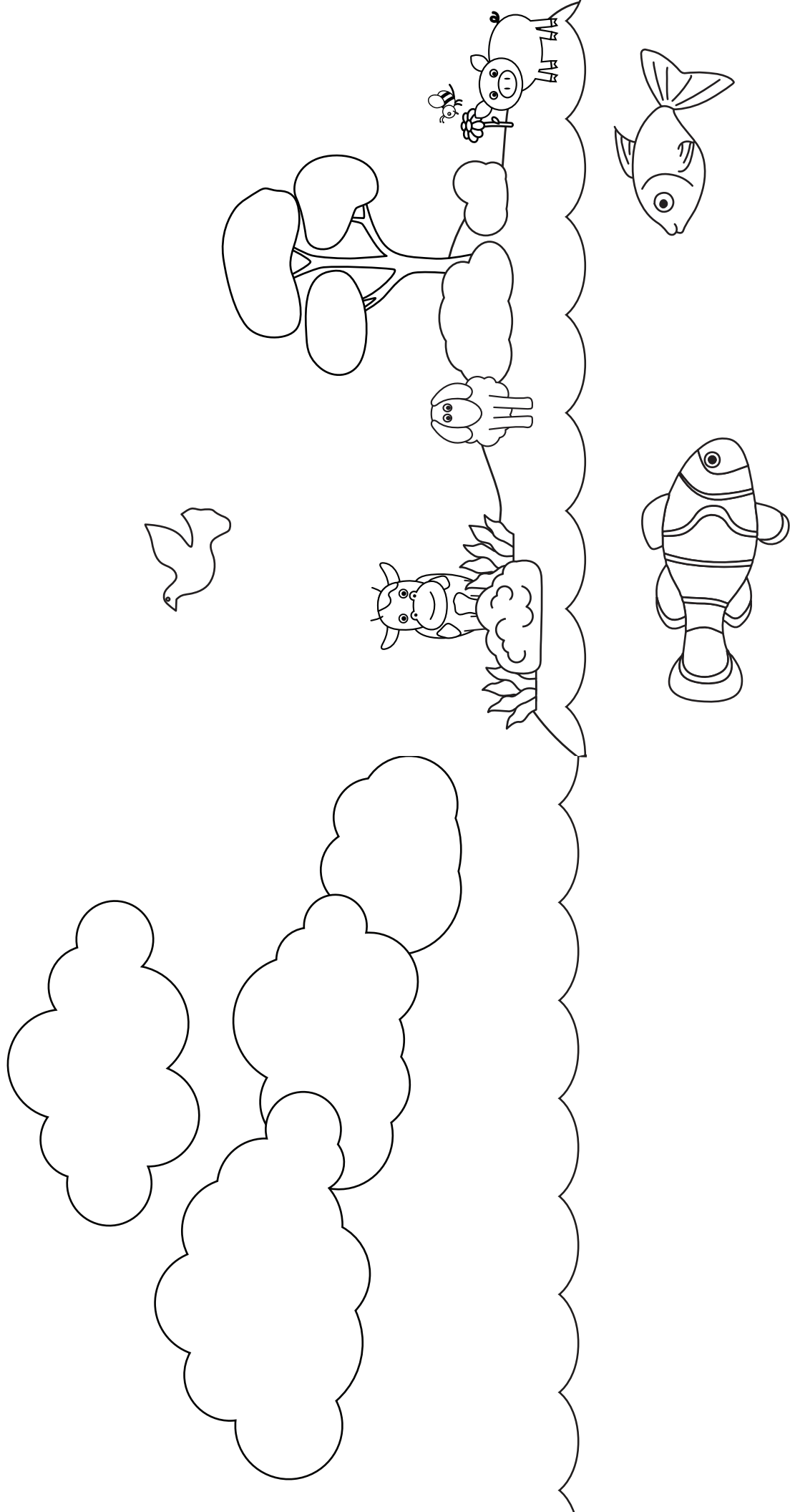
In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Then God said, "I give you every seed-bearing plant on the face of the whole earth and every tree that has fruit with seed in it. They will be yours for food."



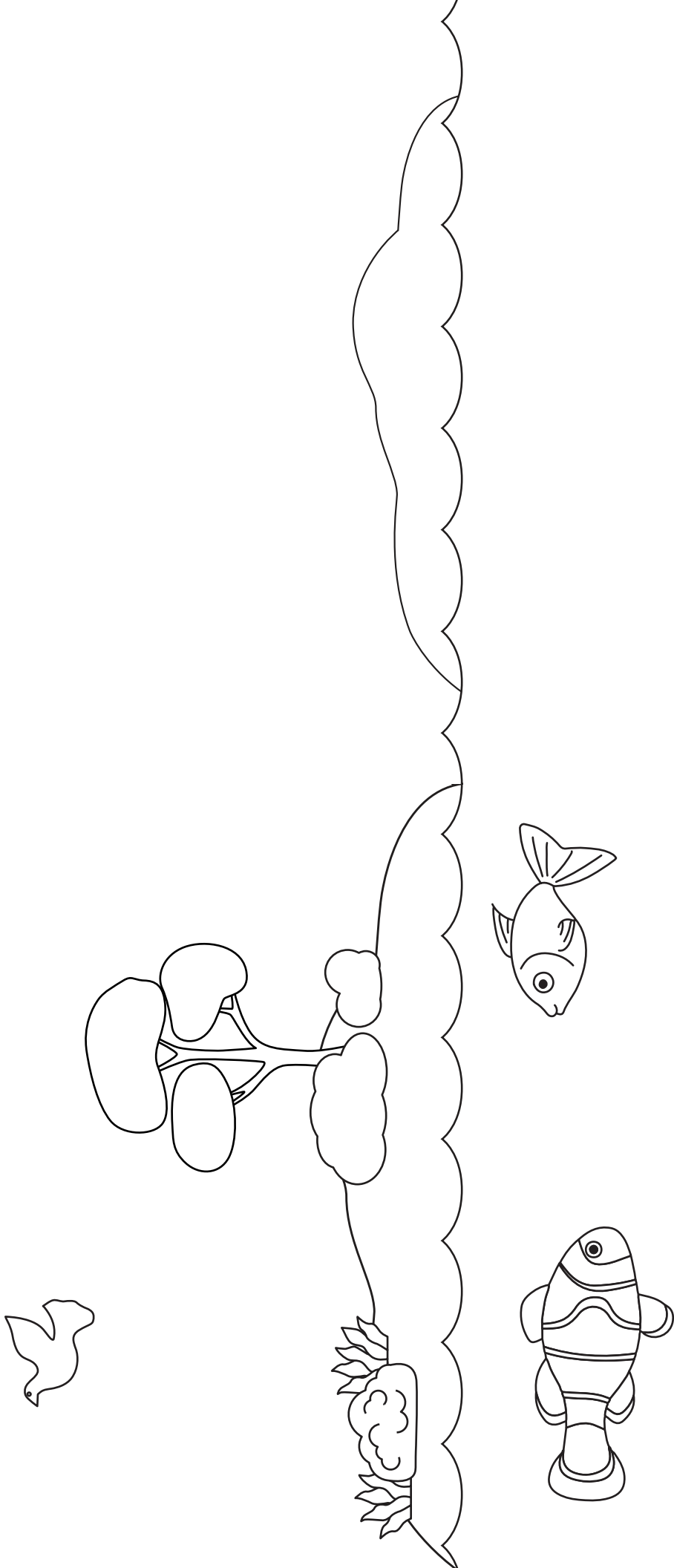

and there was light.



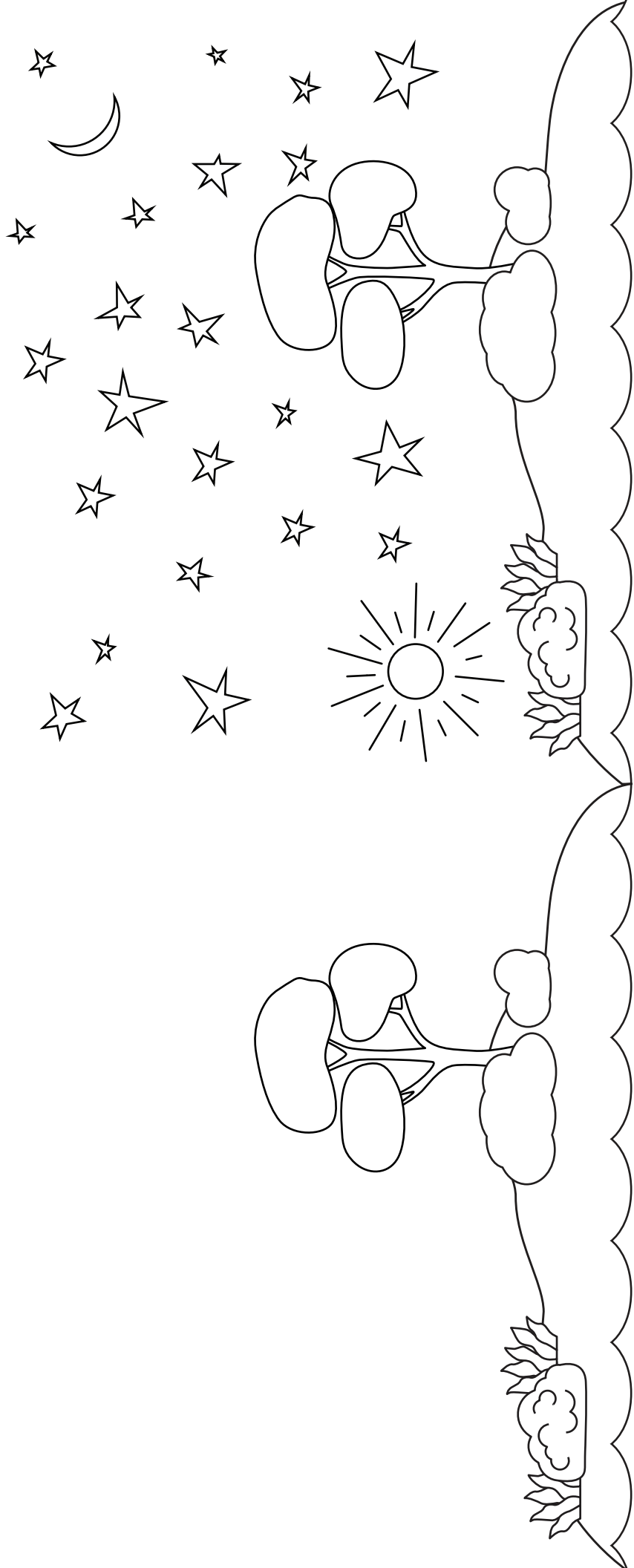
And God said, “Let there be a vault between the waters to separate water from water.”

the earth across the vault of the sky.”

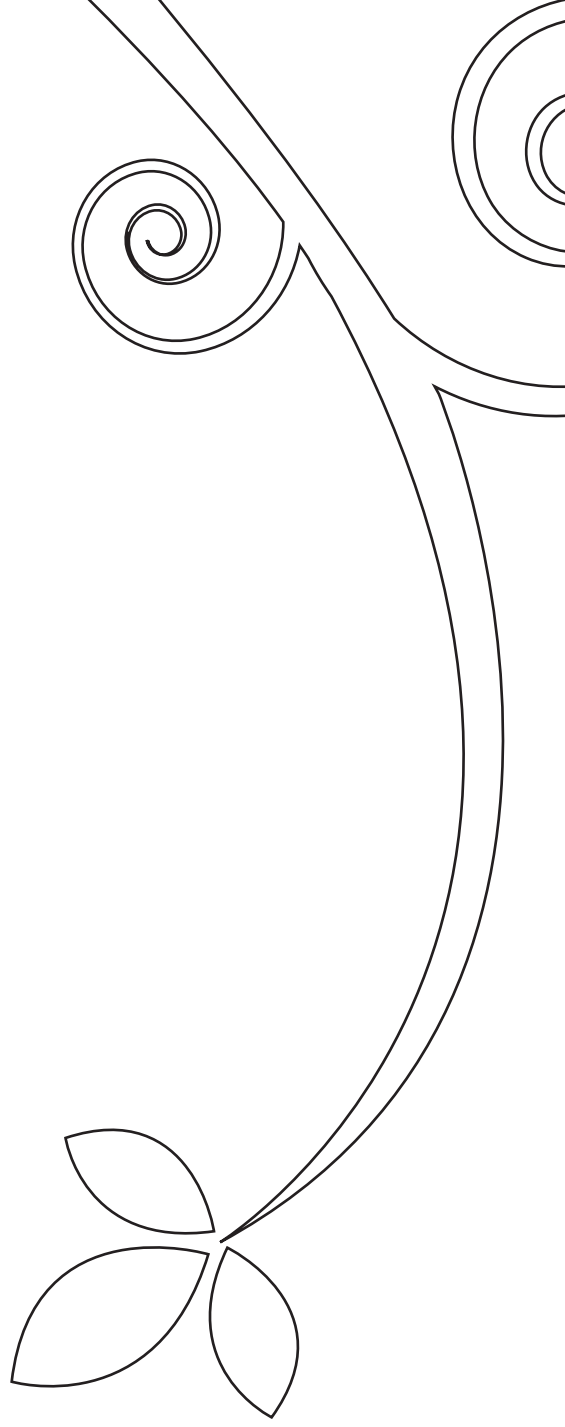
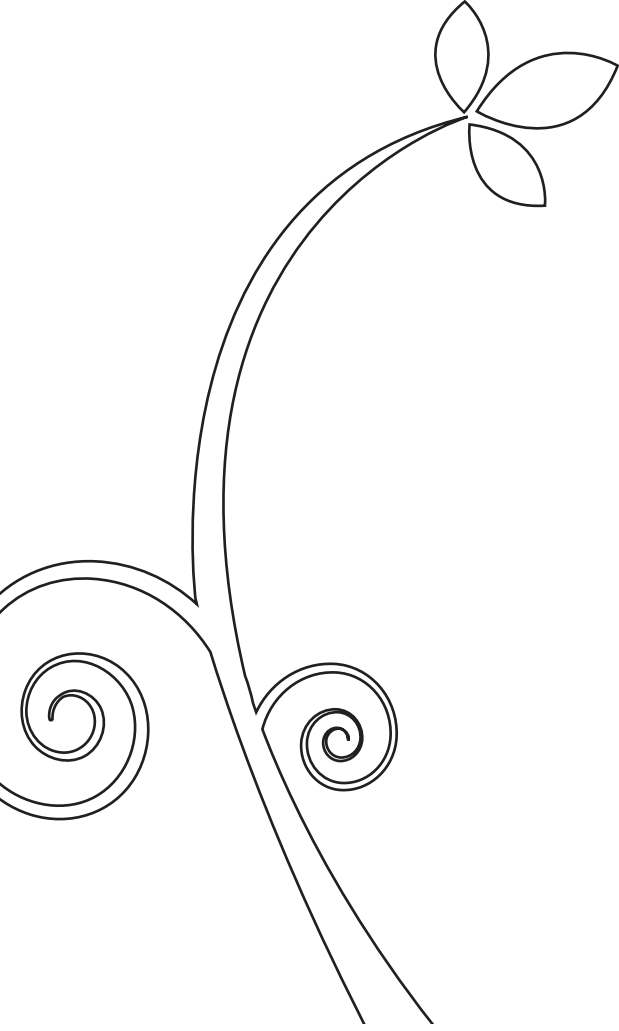
