MATERIALS

ACTIVITY

PSALM 115

TALK: This week we will recap our last class and go over Psalm 115!

MATERIALS

Bible
Figurine

ACTIVITY

CAN'T...

TALK: Other nations worshiped idols, but Israel worshiped the Lord!

ACTIVITY: Today let's read Psalm 115:2-8 and find a figurine/toy/object and go through the ways it cannot speak, hear, smell, feel or walk by itself.

Why do the nations say, "Where is their God?"

Our God is in heaven; he does whatever pleases him.

But their idols are silver and gold, made by human hands.

They have mouths, but cannot speak, eyes, but cannot see.

They have ears, but cannot hear, noses, but cannot smell.

They have hands, but cannot feel, feet, but cannot walk, can they utter a sound with their throats.

Those who make them will be like them, and so will all who trust in them.

FOCUS

The Lord is our help and shield!

MATERIALS

Bible
Plain paper
Crayons

ACTIVITY

HELP & SHIELD

TALK: God is our help and shield because we fear and trust Him and how he blesses us!

ACTIVITY: Today let's read Psalm 115:9-13 and draw ourselves holding a shield and ways the Lord has blessed us!

All you Israelites, trust in the Lord—he is their help and shield.
House of Aaron, trust in the Lord—he is their help and shield.
You who fear him, trust in the Lord—he is their help and shield.

The Lord remembers us and will bless us: He will bless his people Israel, he will bless the house of Aaron, he will bless those who fear the Lord—small and great alike.

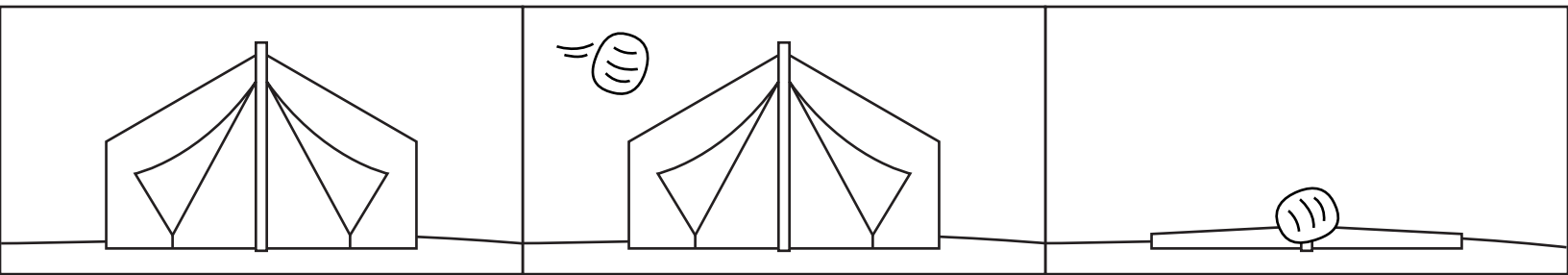
GIDEON IS AFRAID TO FIGHT THE ENEMY
