PHARAOH'S DREAMS

FOCUS

GENESIS 41:1-8, 14-17, 36 & 41-42

Pharaoh had two dreams! The first dream was about cows and the second grain!
Both dreams meant the same thing!
There would be 7 years of plenty followed by 7 years of famine!

MATERIALS

Pharaoh's Dreams picture

Pharaoh's Headress and ring pop (1 set per child)

Cupbearer & Joseph with chains actors

Prison

7 fat & 7 skinny cows

7 heads of good grain & 7 heads of bad grain

Egypt model

What Does the Dream Mean? coloring page (2 for Joseph + 2 per child)

Crackers (7 per child) & a small cup *large enough* to hold the 7 crackers

Crayons, glue, scissors & tape

ACTIVITIES

1. TNTRODUCTION

TALK: Ask the children if they know about Pharaoh's two dreams!

ACTIVITY: Show children the Pharaoh's Dreams picture and hang nearby for them to see.

CORRESPONDING VERSE

2. PHARAOH & JOSEPH

TALK: Pharaoh was the king of Egypt! While Joseph, Jacob's son, was in prison, Pharaoh had a dream!

ACTIVITY: Help the children color and assemble the pharaoh hat and put on a signet ring (ring pop). Then take them to see the Joseph actor with **chains** in "**prison**".



WHEN TWO FULL YEARS HAD PASSED, PHARAOH HAD A DREAM.

GENESIS 41:1

3. 1ST DRFAM

TALK: In Pharaoh's first dream there were 7 fat cows coming up out of the Nile river! Then 7 ugly and skinny cows came up out of the Nile river and ate the seven fat cows!

ACTIVITY: Have the children color and assemble the 7 fat cows, place them in the river in the Egypt model, then and have them come up out of the river and onto the land. Then have them assemble and color the 7 skinny cows, place them in the river, come up out of the river, and then eat the 7 fat cows!



CORRESPONDING **VERSE**

HE WAS STANDING BY THE NIE WHEN OUT OF THE RIVER THERE CAME UP SEVEN COWS, SLEEK AND FAT. AND THEY GRAZED ALONG THE REEDS. AFTER THEM. SEVEN OTHER COWS. UGLY AND GAUNT, CAME UP OUT OF THE NILE AND STOOD BESIDE THOSE ON THE RIVERBANK, AND THE COWS THAT WERE UGLY AND GAUNT ATE UP THE SEVEN SLEEK, FAT COWS.

GENESIS 41:1-4

4. 2ND DRFAM

TALK: Pharaoh had a second dream about grain! There were 7 heads of good grain growing on one stalk. Then 7 bad heads of grain spouted and swallowed up the 7 good heads of grain!

ACTIVITY: Have the children place the 7 good heads on the large stalk. Next have them add the 7 bad heads underneath it. Then take the good heads off the stalk and move the bad heads up.



HE FELL ASLEEP AGAIN AND HAD A SECOND DREAM: SEVEN HEADS OF GRAIN, HEALTHY AND GOOD, WE'RE GROWING ON A SINGLE STALK. AFTER THEM. SEVEN OTHER HEADS OF GRAIN SPROLITED—THIN AND SCORCHED BY THE FAST WIND. THE THIN HEADS OF GRAIN SWALLOWED UP THE SEVEN HEALTHY, FULL HEADS. THEN PHARAOH WOKE UP; IT HAD BEEN A DREAM.

GENESIS 41:5-7

5. WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

TALK: Pharaoh woke up and was troubled! He knew his dream had been important, but he did not know why! He sent for all the wise men in Egypt to come and tell him what his dream meant, but no one could tell him.

ACTIVITY: Have the children tell the two dreams to their parents, then ask them what it means. Then have the parent's tell them that they do not know what it means!

6. CUPBFARFR

TALK: Pharaoh was sad, no one could tell him what his dream meant! Then his cupbearer remembered that when he had a dream and wanted to know what it meant, Jospeh told him! So Pharaoh asked Joseph to come!

ACTIVITY: Have the cupbearer actor come and say, "Joseph can tell you what it means, but he's in prison!" Then have the children say, "Bring Joseph!"

7. JOSEPH

TALK: Joseph came to see Pharaoh and he told him his dreams so that Joseph could tell him what they meant!

ACTIVITY: Have the Joseph actor come forward, then have the children ask Joseph if he can tell them what his dream means. Then have Joseph say "I can't do it, but God can!"

CORRESPONDING VERSE

IN THE MORNING HIS MIND WAS TROUBLED, SO HE SENT FOR ALL THE MAGICIANS AND WISE MEN OF EGYPT. PHARAOH TOLD THEM HIS DREAMS, BUT NO ONE COULD INTERPRET THEM FOR HIM. GENESIS 41:8

JOSEPH, AND HE WAS

DUNGEON. WHEN HE SHAVED

8. BOTH DREAMS

TALK: Pharaoh told Joseph his dreams! The dream about the 7 fat and thin cows and the dream about the 7 good and bad heads of grain!

ACTIVITY: Have the children tell Jospeh the dreams, while Joseph is drawing pictures in the "Dream" boxes on the paper. Then have the children repeat the drawings on their paper.

9. WHAT THEY MEAN

TALK: After Joseph heard all about the dreams, God helped him to figure out what it meant! The dreams both meant the same thing! 7 years of plenty followed by 7 years of famine!

ACTIVITY: Have the Joseph actor show his notes to the children and explain what the dreams meant! Then have the children write the interpretation down too!



THEN JOSEPH SAID TO PHARAOH, "THE DREAMS OF PHARAOH ARE ONE AND THE SAME, GOD HAS REVEALED TO PHARAOH WHAT HE IS ABOUT TO DO. THE SEVEN GOOD COWS ARE SEVEN YEARS. AND THE SEVEN GOOD HEADS OF GRAIN ARE SEVEN YEARS; IT IS ONE AND THE SAME DRFAM. THE SEVEN LEAN. UGLY COWS THAT CAME UP AFTERWARD ARE SEVEN YFARS. AND SO ARE THE SEVEN WORTHLESS HEADS OF GAIN SCORCHED BY THE FAST WIND: THEY ARE SEVEN YEARS OF FAMINE."

10. COLLECT

TALK: Pharaoh was happy he knew what the dreams meant, but he needed to make sure his people could survive 7 years of plenty then 7 years of famine! Joseph told him to collect the extra food in the years of plenty and save it for the years of famine!

ACTIVITY: Have each child stand in a line. Tell them that it is year one of the plenty and give them 1 cracker. Have them take a step forward and give them a new cracker, representing year 2 of plenty. Do this for the 7 years with 7 crackers. Then explain that it is now year 1 of the famine and have them give you back a cracker. Repeat this activity until it has been 7 years of famine, and explain that because they collected their crackers, they could survive the 7 years of famine!

11. PROMOTED

TALK: Pharaoh liked Jospeh's plan and made him second in charge of Egypt! He even gave him his signet ring to show that he was in charge!

ACTIVITY: Have children take off their ring and give it to Joseph!


OPTIONAL: Hand out each child a bible verse to take home.


PRISION




LARGE MODEL OF EGYPT

For large model of Egypt I used cedar pickets and 4" PVC pipe.





LARGE MODEL OF EGYPT


I placed 2 8.5"x11" galvanized steel sheets on the front of the model (one on either side). This allowed the decorations to stand upright and become secure on the model. I cut the green and tan felt to size then spray and hot glue gunned the felt on the steel sheets and wood. I painted the wood around the pipe blue to match the painting and added trees and decorations around the model to look more realistic.













1/8"X12"

CUT THE WAVY & REGULAR PIPE CLEANERS IN HALF, SO THERE ARE 7 OF EACH











JOSEPH'S PLAN
