FOCUS

EXODUS 7:17, NUMBERS 19:2, JOSHUA 2:17-18,
ISAIAH 1:18 & 63:2, EZEKIEL 1:13, DANIEL 3:25,
NAHUM 2:3 & REVELATION 6:4

In the Bible the color red can represent
blood, vengeance, sins, cows, horses,
fire, salvation and warriors!

MATERIALS

Red picture
Color wheel (1 per child)
Jar of water with red (1 per child)
White cloth and bowl of water with red food coloring
Stained white cloth, white cloth and bowl of water
Horse craft stick and sword (1 set per child)
Fire hat and fire ball (1 set per child)
Cool Fire coloring page (1 per child)
House with window and 3 cords (white, red and blue yarn)
Red Warrior t-shirt (1 per child)
Crayons, glue, scissors & tape

ACTIVITIES

1. INTRODUCTION

TALK: Ask the children if they know what Red can represent in the bible!

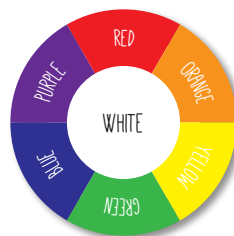
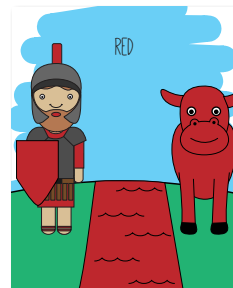
ACTIVITY: Show children the Red picture and hang nearby for them to see.

2. RED

TALK: Red is a color! It is one of the primary colors along with yellow and blue!

ACTIVITY: Give each child a color wheel and point out the color red.

3. BLOOD

TALK: Blood is the color red! The first plague of Egypt was God turning the Nile river into blood!

ACTIVITY: Have the children shake their jar of water and watch it turn red.

4. STAINED RED

TALK: On God’s day of vengeance His white clothes will have red stains! Like he was in a winepress!

ACTIVITY: Have the children dip a white cloth into a bowl of red water.

WHY ARE YOUR GARMENTS RED, LIKE THOSE OF ONE TREADING THE WINEPRESS?

ISAIAH 63:2

5. BRAND NEW

TALK: Jesus died for our sins! When we are forgiven it is like they are gone! Sins on us were like red stains, but with Jesus they are white again!

ACTIVITY: Show the children their red stained white cloth (from the previous activity) and have them try to get the stain out with water, then show them a brand new one.

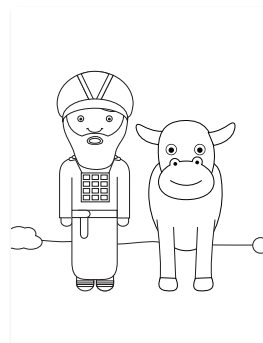

6. RED HEIFER

TALK: The priests were suppose to sacrifice a red heifer that had no spot or blemish!

ACTIVITY: Have the children color the Red Heifer coloring page.



TELL THE ISRAELITES TO BRING YOU A RED HEIFER WITHOUT DEFECT OR BLEMISH.

7. RED HORSE

TALK: In the book of Revelation there was a man holding a sword and riding a red horse! He was meant to take peace from people!

ACTIVITY: Have children color their Horse craft stick red and hold their **swords**.



THEN ANOTHER HORSE CAME OUT, A FIERY RED ONE. ITS RIDER WAS GIVEN POWER TO TAKE PEACE FROM THE EARTH AND TO MAKE PEOPLE KILL EACH OTHER. TO HIM WAS GIVEN A LARGE SWORD.

ACTIVITIES

8. FIRE

TALK: Fire is red! The living creatures Ezekiel saw looked like fire! Fire even moved back and forth between them!

ACTIVITY: Have the children color and make a fire hat. Then have them toss a **fire ball** between them.



CORRESPONDING VERSE

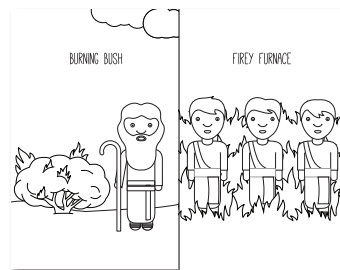
THE APPEARANCE OF THE LIVING CREATURES WAS LIKE BURNING COALS OF FIRE OR LIKE TORCHES. FIRE MOVED BACK AND FORTH AMONG THE CREATURES; IT WAS BRIGHT, AND LIGHTNING FLASHED OUT OF IT.

EZEKIEL 1:13

9. COOL FIRE

TALK: Even though fire is hot, God can protect you from it! He protected the bush, and the three Israelite boys from the fiery furnace!!

ACTIVITY: Have the children color the Cool Fire coloring page.

10. SCARLET CORD

TALK: Rahab and the two spies made a deal! Rahab had kept the spies safe and in return they would save her and her family when the Israelites attacked Jericho! She just had to have a scarlet cord hang from her window!.

ACTIVITY: Have the children choose which cord to place out the cardboard window.

"THIS OATH YOU HAVE MADE US SWEAR WILL NOT BE BINDING ON US, UNLESS, WHEN WE ENTER THE LAND, YOU HAVE TIED THIS SCARLET CORD IN THE WINDOW THROUGH WHICH YOU HAVE LET US DOWN."

11. WARRIOR

TALK: In the book of Nahum there are warriors with red shields wearing red clothes!

ACTIVITY: Give each child a red shirt that says Warrior and a **red shield** to color.



THE SHIELDS OF THE SOLDIERS ARE RED; THE WARRIORS ARE CLAD IN SCARLET.

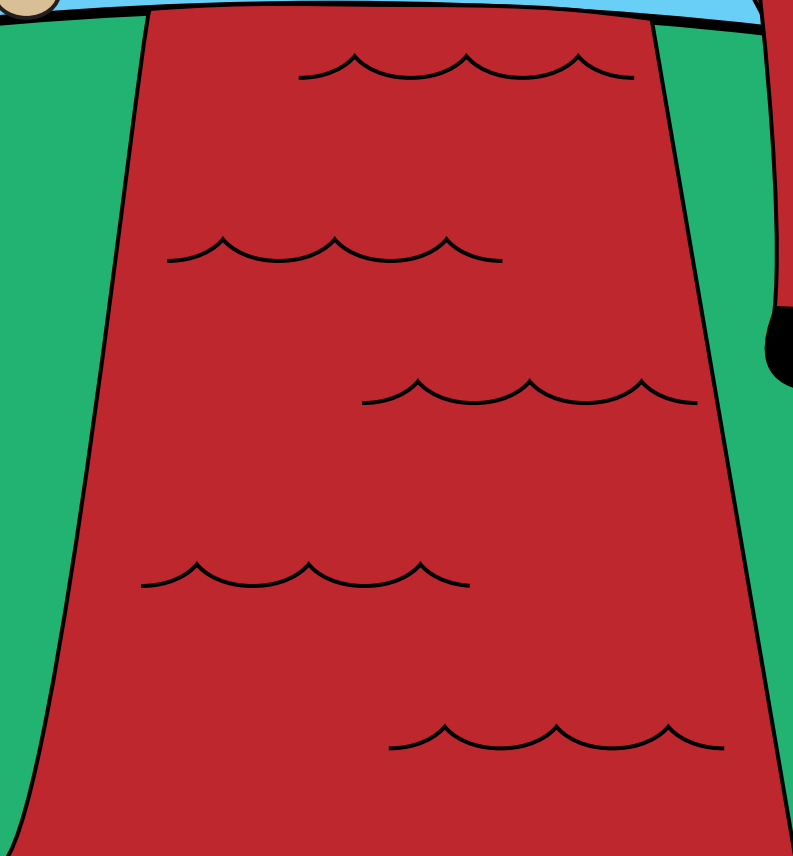
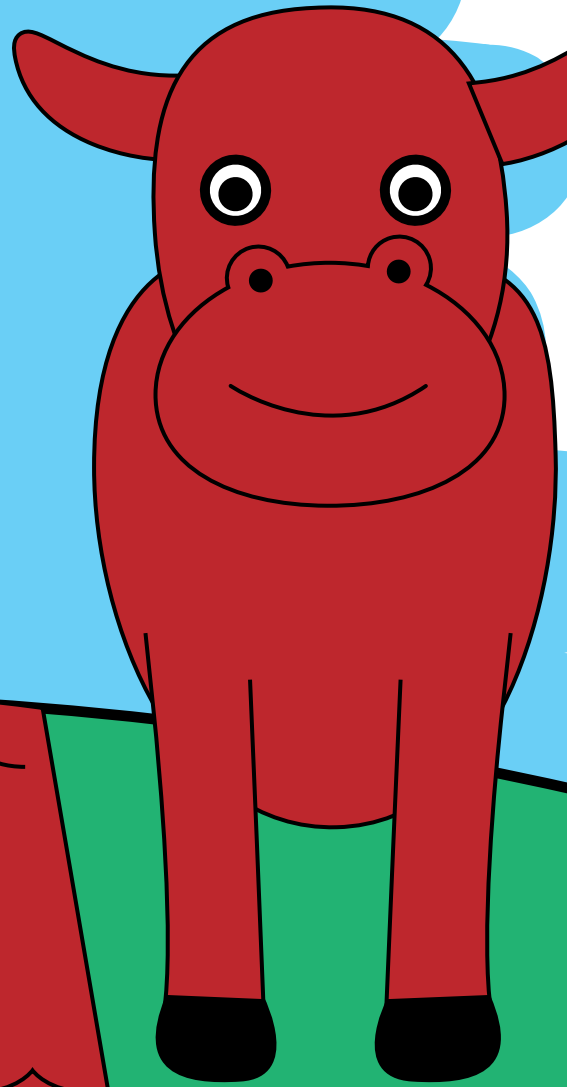

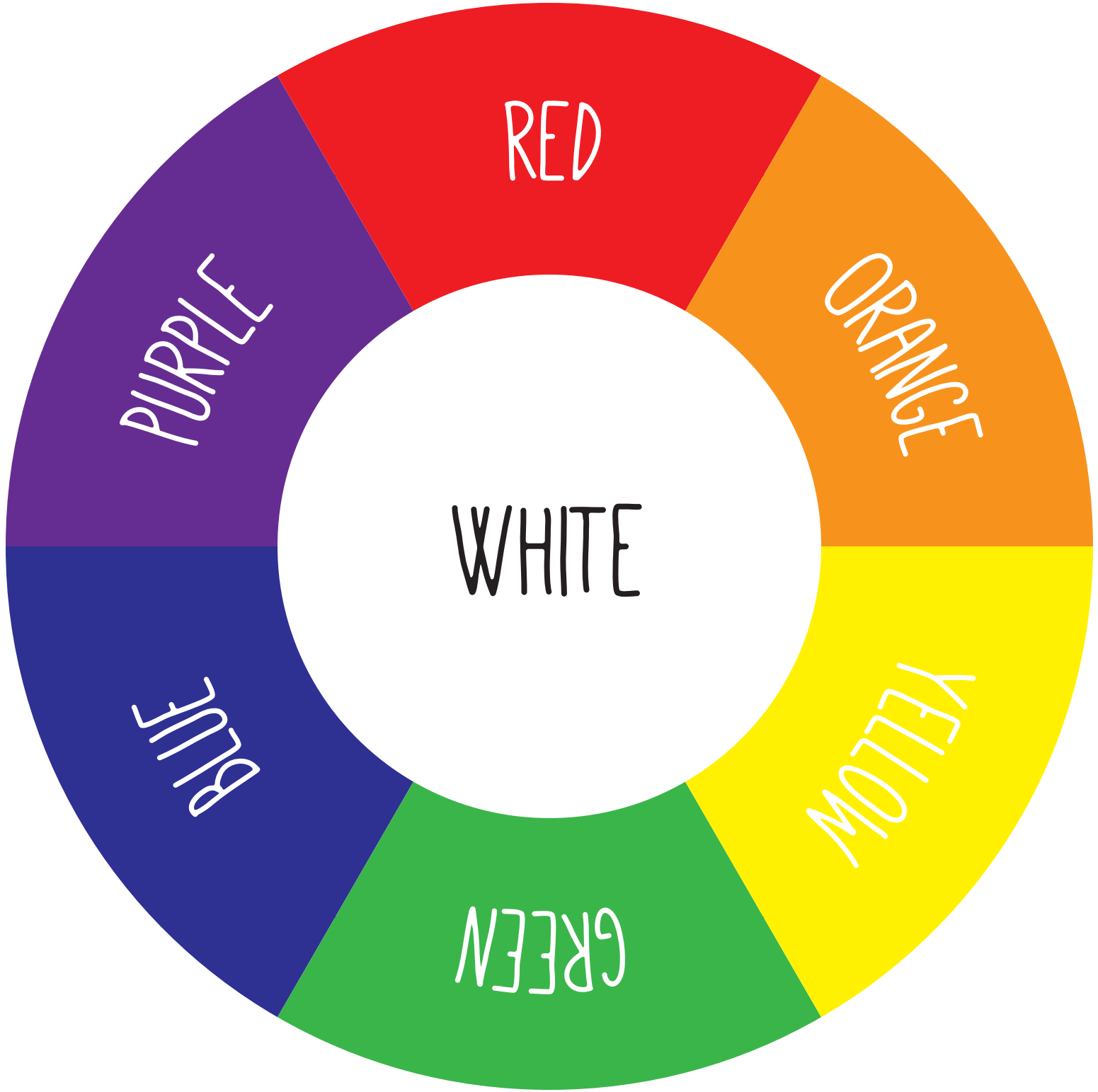
OPTIONAL: Hand out each child a bible verse to take home.

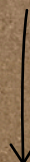

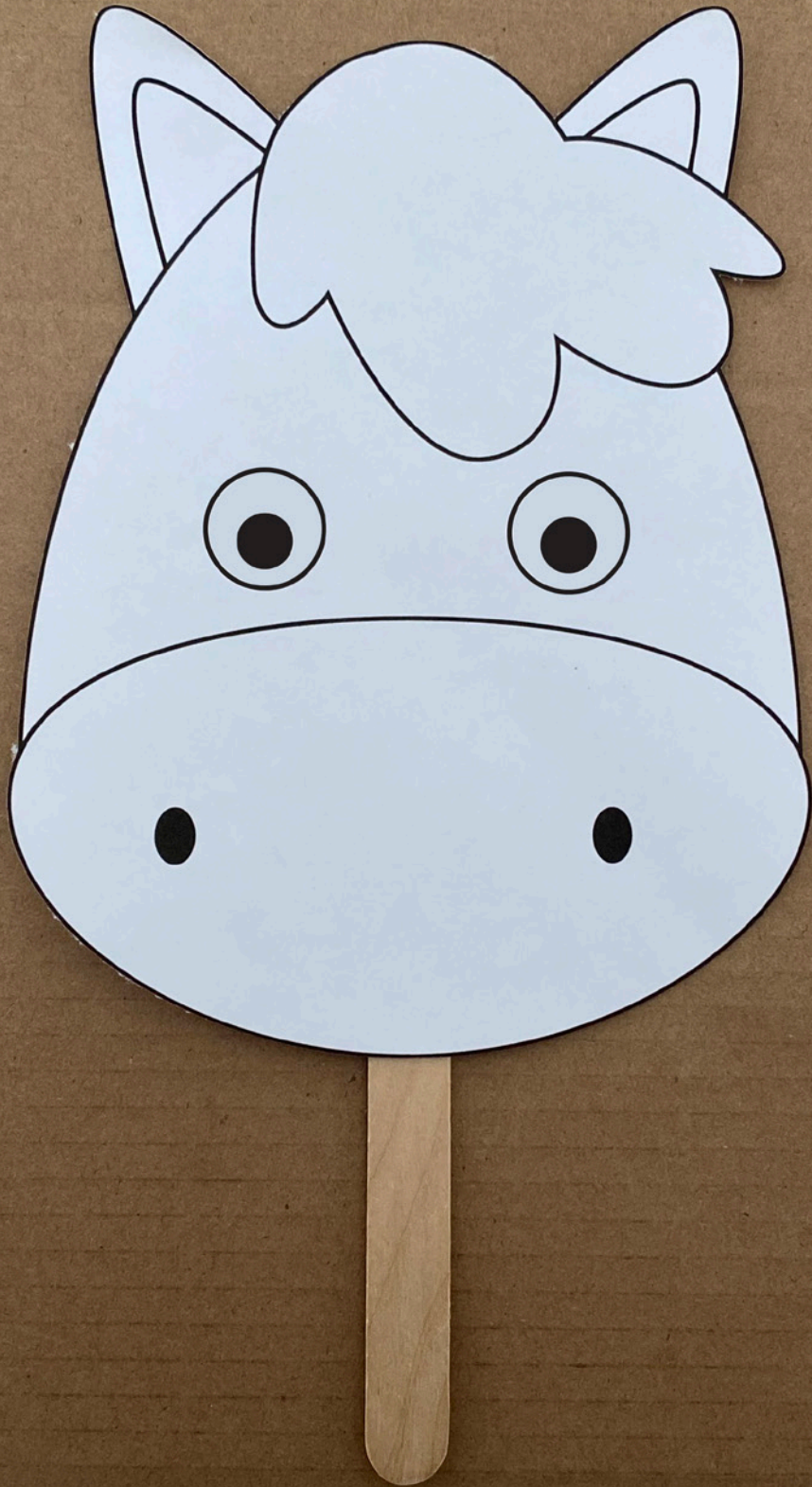

JUMBO POPSICLE STICKS

DIRECTIONS

1. LIGHTLY SAND PAINT STICK WITH 120 SAND PAPER SO EDGES ARE SMOOTH AND ROUNDED



2. PRIME PAINT STICK WITH 2 COATS OF WHITE PAINT

(SAND WITH 220 SAND PAPER BETWEEN COATS)



3. PAINT STICK WITH 2 COATS OF GRAY PAINT

(SAND WITH 220 SAND PAPER BETWEEN COATS & WHEN FINISHED USE 400 SAND PAPER TO SMOOTH)



*OPTIONAL: ADD THIRD PAINT COAT WITH SILVER PAINT

4. GLUE POPSICLE STICKS 5" FROM THE EDGE OF THE SWORD THEN WRAP WITH TAPE

1 STICK ON BOTTOM



1 STICK ON TOP



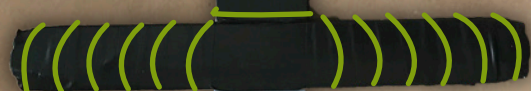
WRAP HERE FIRST TO COVER EDGE (BOTH SIDES)



THEN WRAP THE SIDES AND HILT IN A SPIRAL TO COVER ALL WOOD AND BIND THE STICKS TOGETHER



THEN HERE TO COVER EDGE AND MIDDLE (BOTH SIDES)





FIRE ON RED CONSTRUCTION PAPER



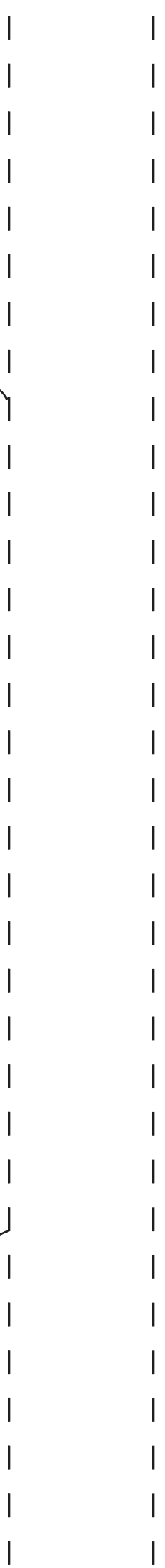
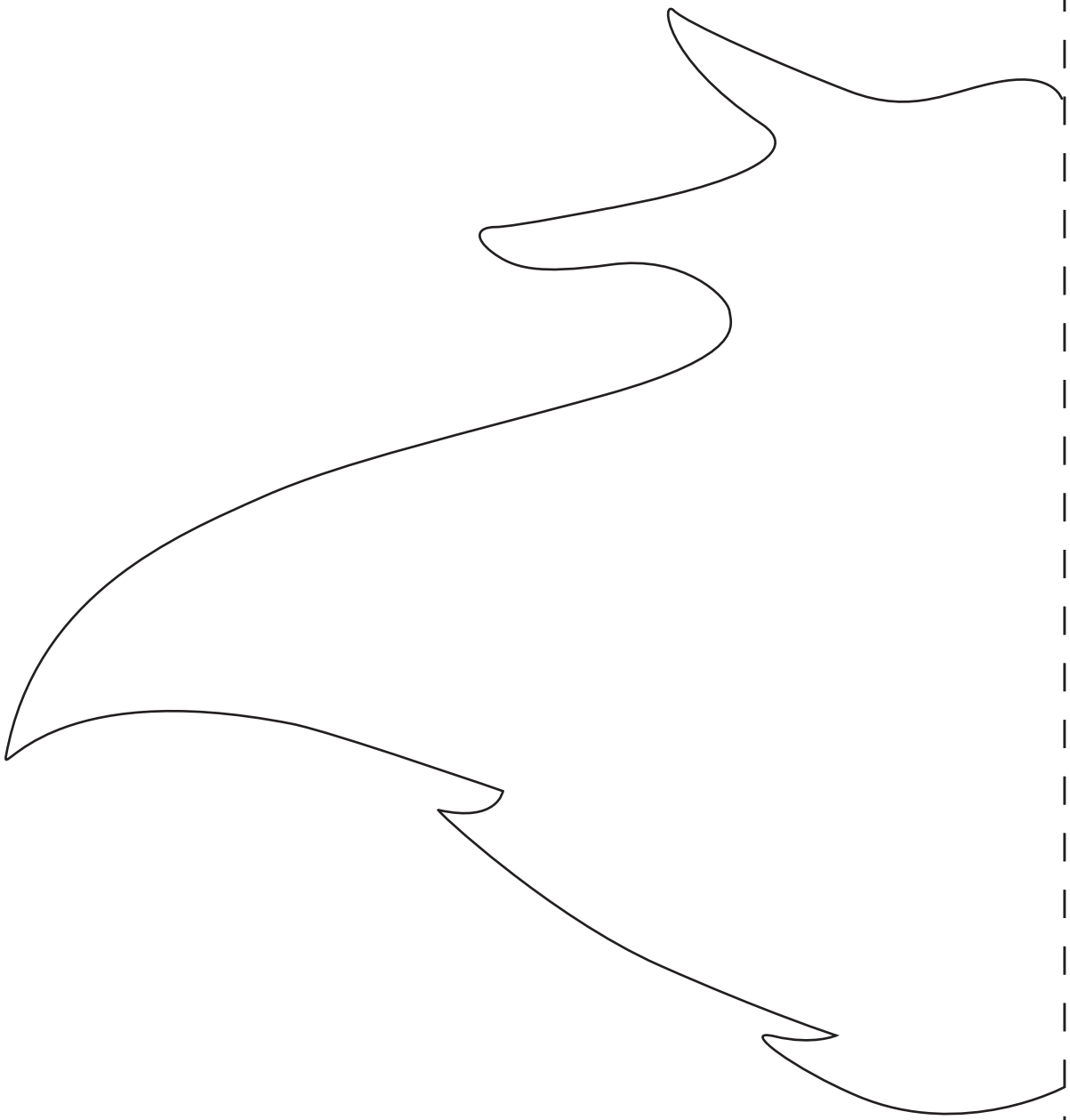
CUT 2 STRIPS OF

FIRE HAT



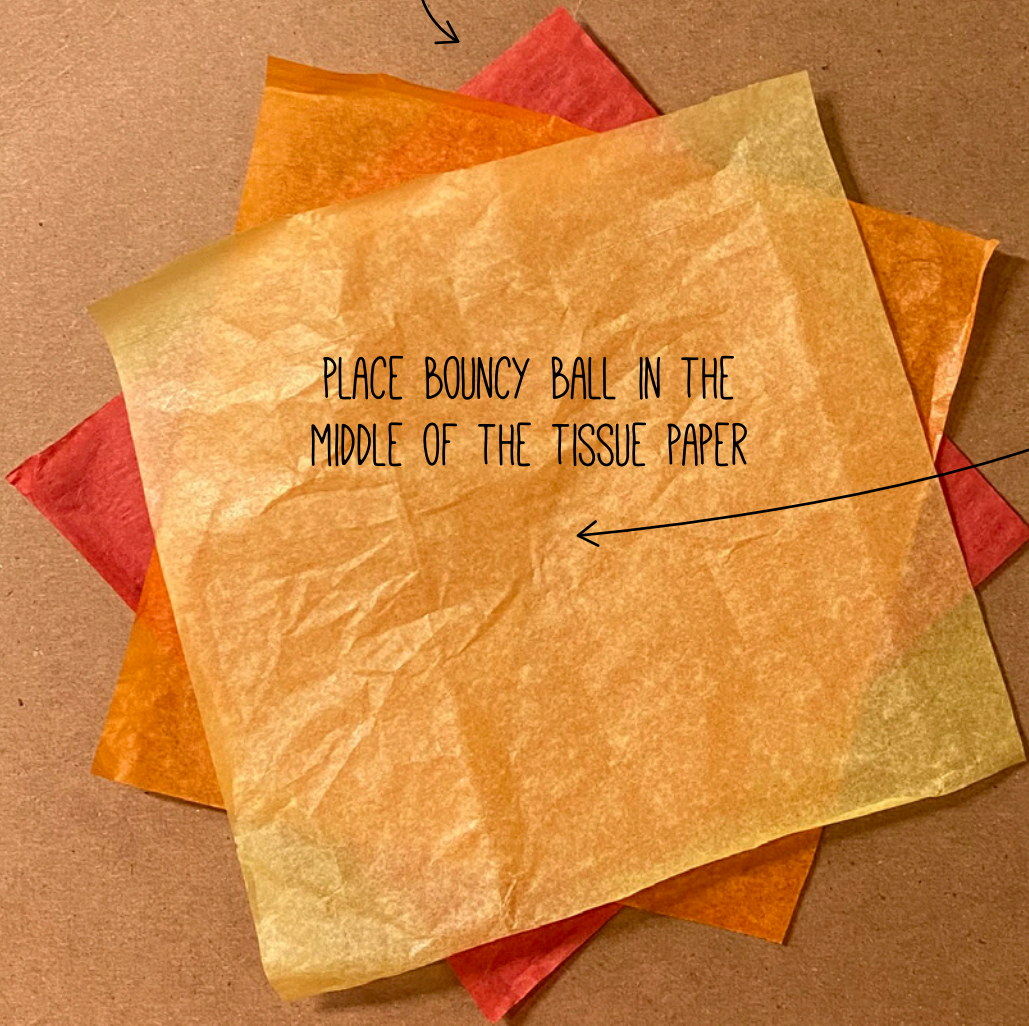
TAPE OR STAPLE

MIDDLE OF THE TISSUE PAPER



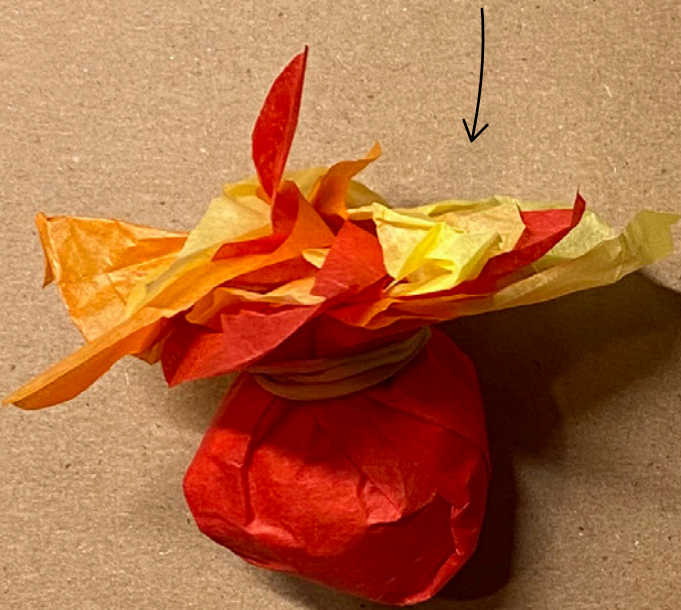

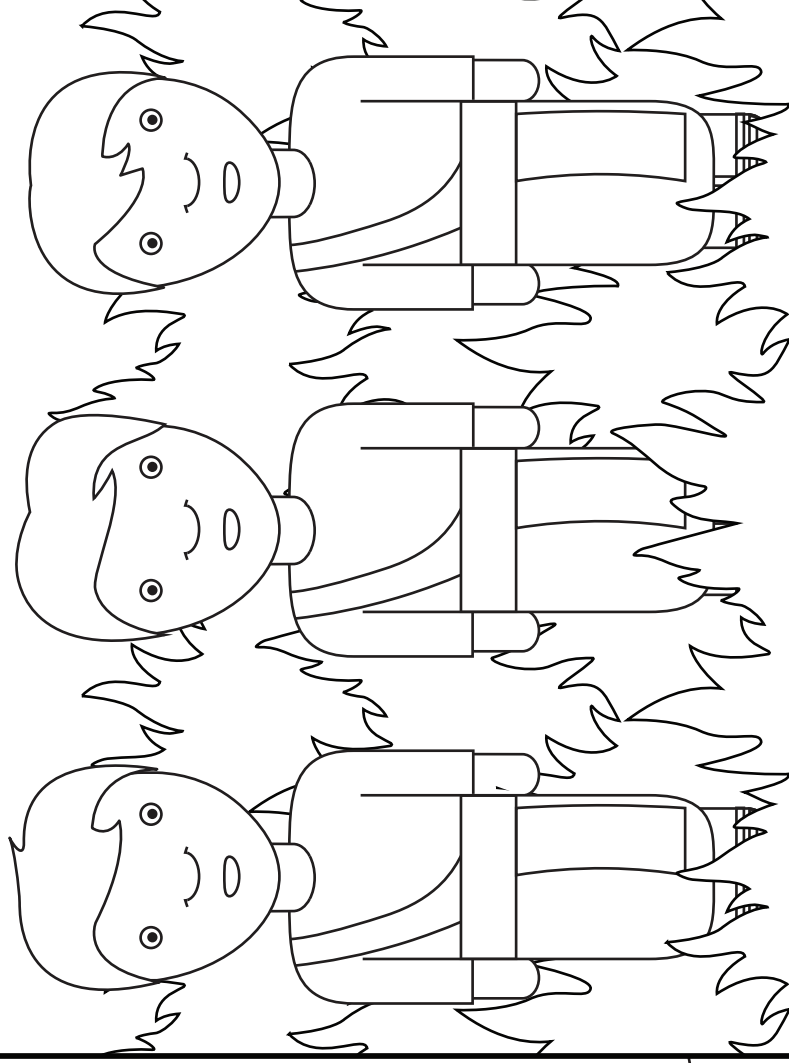
SMALL RUBBERBAND

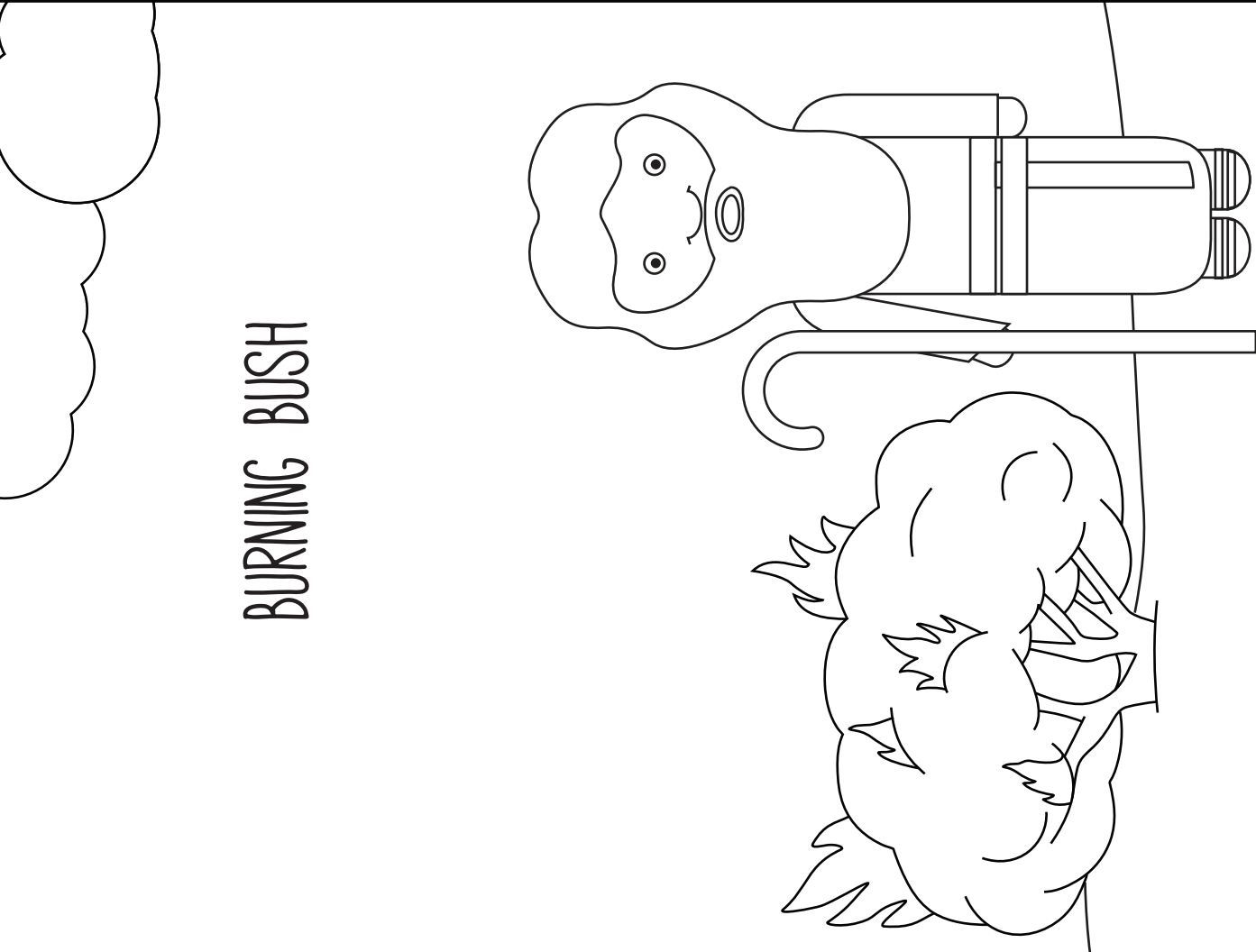
WRAP THE TISSUE PAPER AROUND THE BALL

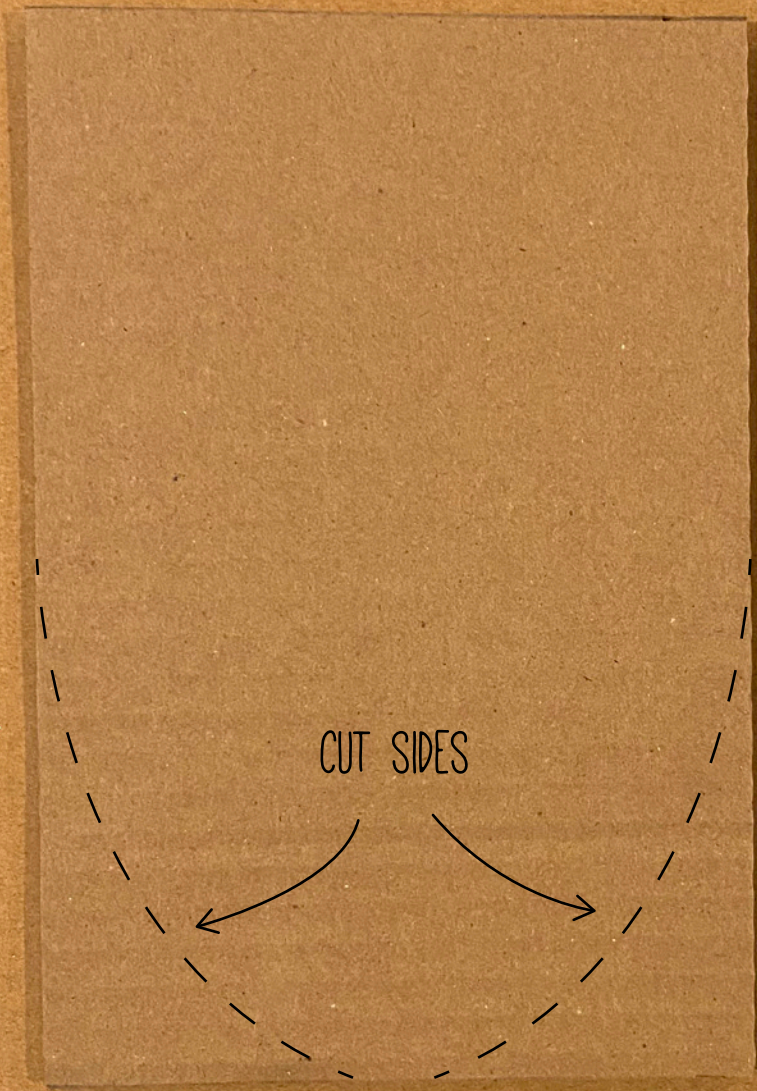
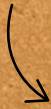
SCARLET CORD

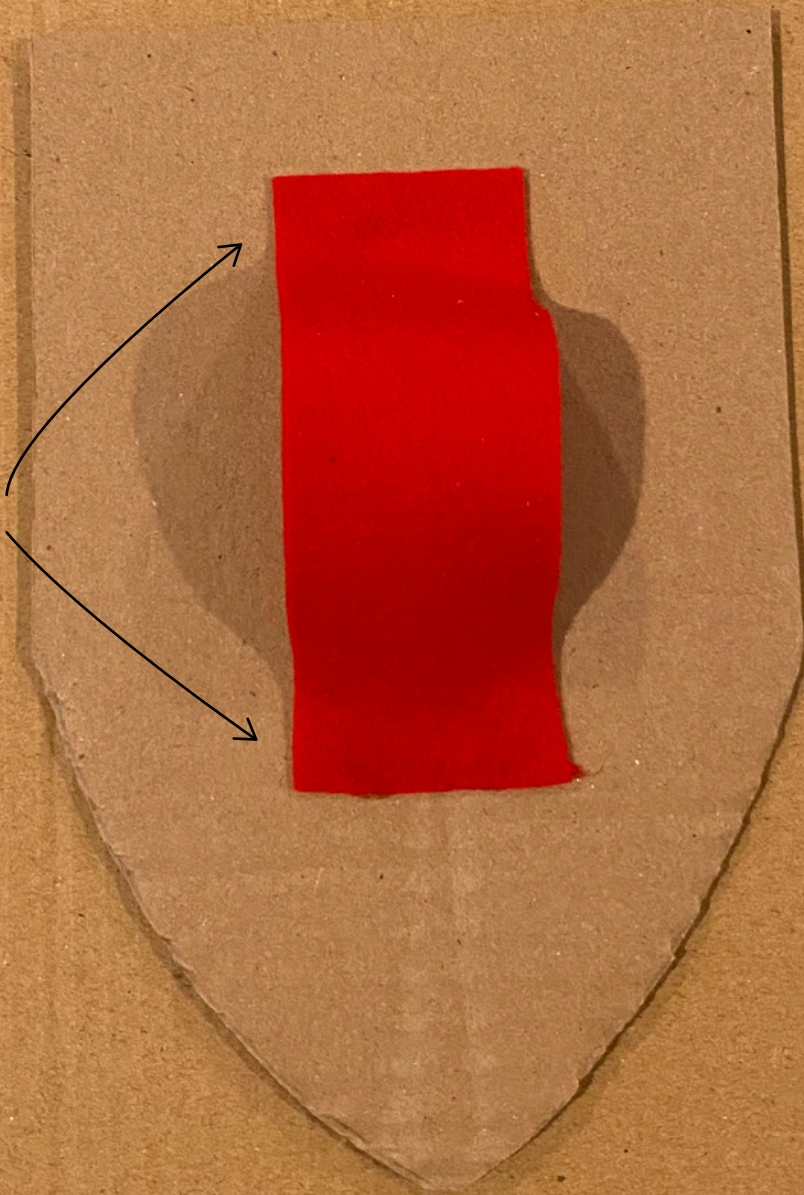

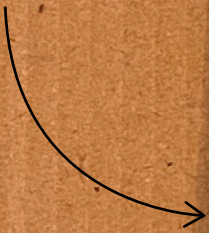
RED SHIELD
