COLORS

THE FIRST PLAGUE

FOCUS

The first Egyptian plague.

MATERIALS

Red food coloring (or something similar)

Cup of water

ACTIVITY

TURNED RED

TALK: The first plague in Egypt was God changing the Nile river from water into blood!

ACTIVITY: Today let's read Exodus 7:17 and grab some food coloring (or something similar) and a glass of water. Have your Tiny Arrow help you put a drop of food coloring in the water and watch it change colors!

CORRESPONDING VERSE

"WITH THE STAFF THAT IS IN MY HAND I WILL STRIKE THE WATER OF THE NILE, AND IT WILL BE CHANGED INTO BLOOD."

DAY 2

COLORS

SINS

FOCUS

With Jesus' blood our sins turn white!

MATERIALS

Something red
Something white

ACTIVITY

RED TO WHITE

TALK: With Jesus' blood our sins that were red become white!

ACTIVITY: Today let's read Isaiah 1:18 and have your Tiny Arrow find something red and find something white! Then show them the red object and tell them that the color represents our sins. Then show them the white object and tell them that with Jesus' blood they are white!

CORRESPONDING VERSE

"COME NOW, LET US SETTLE THE MATTER," SAYS THE LORD. "THOUGH YOUR SINS ARE LIKE SCARLET, THEY SHALL BE AS WHITE AS SNOW; THOUGH THEY ARE RED AS CRIMSON, THEY SHALL BE LIKE WOOL."

HORSES

FOCUS

The second horse in the book of Revelation chapter 6 was red!

MATERIALS

Horse coloring page
Crayons

ACTIVITY

RED

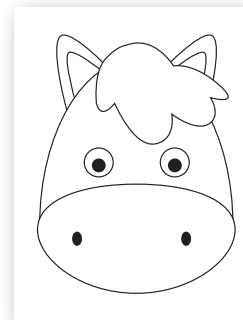
TALK: In the book of Revelation there were four colored horses! The first one was white, the second one was red, the third one was black and the fourth one was pale green!

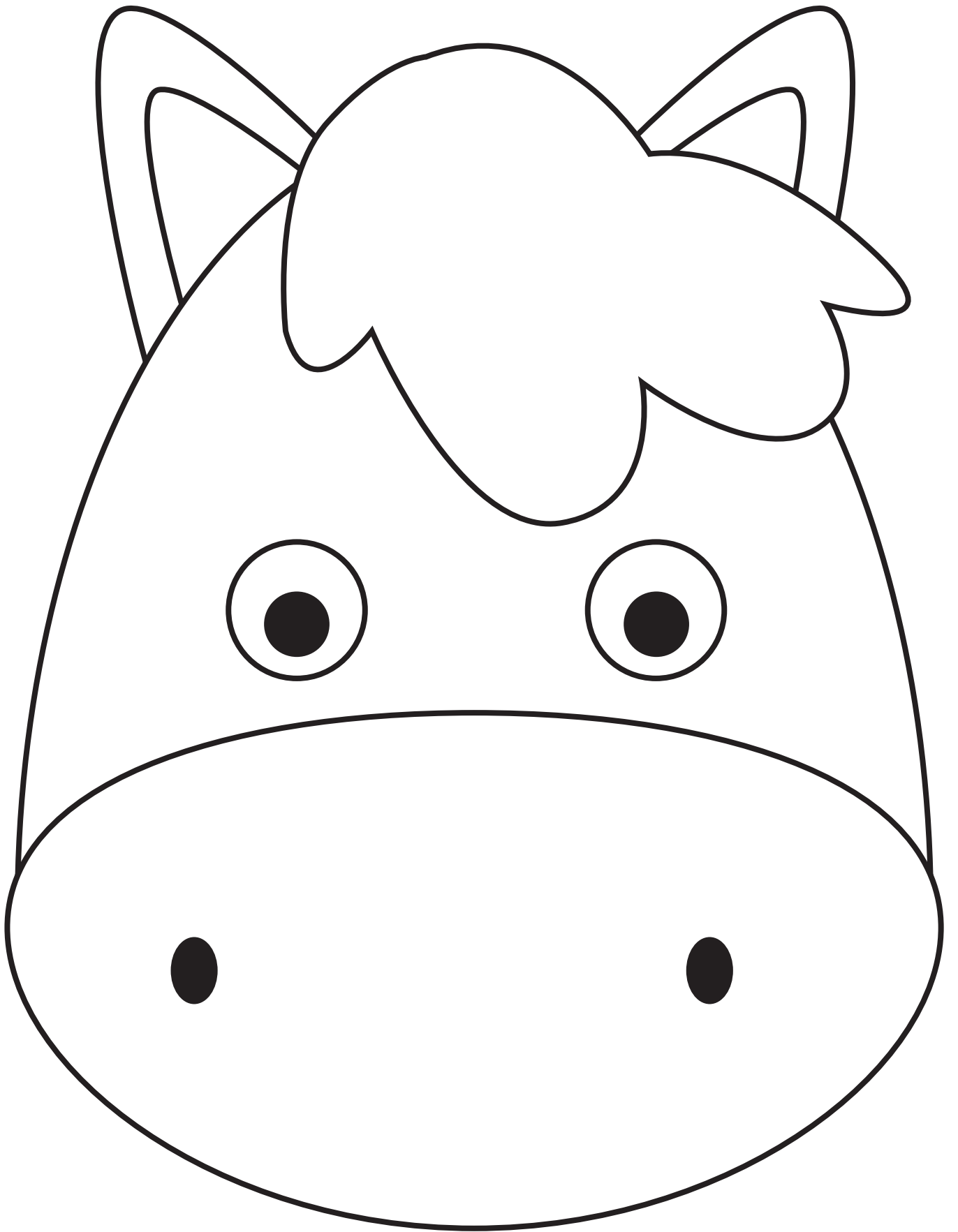
ACTIVITY: Today let's read Revelation 6:4 and color the horse red!

CORRESPONDING VERSE

THEN ANOTHER HORSE CAME OUT, A FIERY RED ONE. ITS RIDER WAS GIVEN POWER TO TAKE PEACE FROM THE EARTH AND TO MAKE PEOPLE KILL EACH OTHER. TO HIM WAS GIVEN A LARGE SWORD.

DAY 4

COLORS

FIRE

FOCUS

God made the hot fire cool!

MATERIALS

Red paper
Scissors

ACTIVITY

COOL

TALK: Fire is red! Although fire is hot, God can you protect you from fire! He protected a bush from burning up and he protected 3 Jewish men from the fiery furnace!

ACTIVITY: Today let's read Exodus 3:2 and Daniel 3:25 and grab some red paper and cut it to look like fire. Tell your Tiny Arrow that it represents fire and fire is hot! Then take the paper outside and have it sit on a plant or bush and tell them that God saved the bush from the fire! Then put the paper on yourself or your Tiny Arrow and explain that God saved three Jewish men from the fire too!

CORRESPONDING VERSE

THERE THE ANGEL OF THE LORD APPEARED TO HIM IN FLAMES OF FIRE FROM WITHIN A BUSH. MOSES SAW THAT THOUGH THE BUSH WAS ON FIRE IT DID NOT BURN UP.
