FOCUS

The beginning to day 2 of creation.

MATERIALS

Bible

ACTIVITY

EVERYTHING

TALK: In the beginning God made everything!

ACTIVITY: Today let's read Genesis 1:1-8 to your Tiny Arrows to go over the beginning and first two days of creation!

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.

And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light. God saw that the light was good, and he separated the light from the darkness. God called the light "day," and the darkness he called "night." And there was evening, and there was morning—the first day.

And God said, "Let there be a vault between the waters to separate water from water." So God made the vault and separated the water under the vault from the water above it. And it was so. God called the vault "sky." And there was evening, and there was morning—the second day.

Blue crayon

ACTIVITY

BLUE

TALK: In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth!
All you could see on the earth was water!

ACTIVITY: Today let's read Genesis 1:1-2 and help your Tiny Arrow draw a circle and color it blue!

CORRESPONDING VERSE

IN THE BEGINNING GOD

DAY 1

FOCUS

God made light!

MATERIALS

ACTIVITY

DAYTIME

TALK: On the first day of creation God made light! He even called the light day and the dark night!

ACTIVITY: Today let's read Genesis 1:3-5 and take your Tiny Arrow into a room with a light switch. Make sure the blinds are closed and stand with your Tiny Arrow by the switch. Turn off the lights so it is dark and say on day one God made light! As you turn the light switch on, say God said "Let there be light!"

CORRESPONDING VERSE

AND GOD SAID, "LET THERE BE LIGHT;" AND THERE WAS LIGHT. GOD SAW THAT THE LIGHT WAS GOOD, AND HE SEPARATED THE LIGHT FROM THE DARKNESS. GOD CALLED THE LIGHT "DAY;" AND THE DARKNESS HE CALLED "NIGHT." AND THERE WAS EVENING, AND THERE WAS MORNING—THE FIRST DAY.

FOCUS

On day 2 God made the sky.

MATERIALS

ACTIVITY

SKY

TALK: On the second day of creation God made the sky!

ACTIVITY: Today let's read Genesis 1:6-8 and take your Tiny Arrow outside and ask them what they see in the sky.

BONUS: Take your Tiny Arrow outside at night and have them look up in the sky and tell you what they see!

CORRESPONDING VERSE

AND GOD SAID, "LET THERE BE A VAULT BETWEEN THE WATERS TO SEPARATE WATER FROM WATER." SO GOD MADE THE VAULT AND SEPARATED THE WATER UNDER THE VAULT FROM THE WATER ABOVE IT. AND IT WAS SO. GOD CALLED THE VAULT "SKY." AND THERE WAS EVENING, AND THERE WAS MORNING—THE SECOND DAY.
